For example, as the Vice-President of Equity and Inclusion on the Berkeley PTA Council, I recently implemented an anti-bias training for all new PTA officers in Berkeley so that we could improve our engagement with families of color in our district. Ensuring the proper representation of Asian Pacific American families in the various leadership roles at our schools is very important to me. Latinos and Asian Pacific American families are often "othered" when we speak our native languages. We share a common bond in our fight against racism.

CANDIDATE QUESTIONS

1. What differentiates you from your opponents for the elected office that you are seeking?

I am the only candidate with the endorsement of the entire current Berkeley School Board as well as the only candidate with professional experience working on COVID-19 recovery efforts for schools. It would be my greatest honor to serve our students and to bring my practical government experience and strong fiscal management skills to the Berkeley School Board.

2. Describe one issue for the district you want to represent for which you have provided leadership and about which you are passionate.

As the daughter of an educator, I feel passionately about advocating for a living wage for education workers. For this reason, I was a big supporter of Measures E, G, and H in Berkeley and worked alongside our teacher's union, the Berkeley Federation of Teachers, to ensure that our education workers received a salary increase of 7%. These salary increase also included classified staff, who are often educators of color in our schools. I canvassed and played an active role in this campaign. Once elected, I will continue to fight to support our education workers so they can afford to live in the city where they work.

3. What percentage of the district you [or intend to] represent are of APA heritage?8% of our children are Asian.

I have met various Vietnamese American families who need improved culturally responsive support for their students. We have over 40 languages spoken in BUSD but only translate materials into Spanish occasionally. We need improved translation for APA families who are monolingual.

7. During the COVID-19 pandemic, reports of anti-Asian verbal and physical attacks have arisen. If you are the incumbent, how have you addressed this? If you are a candidate how will you address this?

I will address this by continuing to host anti-bias trainings for our schools, as I have done in my role as the Vice-President of Equity and Inclusion on the Berkeley PTA Council. I will also build coalition between different communities such as the Latinx Community and APA community to host joint community forums against anti-immigrant rhetoric. Furthemore, in the current culture of anti blackness that has emerged, it's time for all communities of color to stand united against the pandemic of white supremacy that has plagued our country. We are being hit by two pandemics (one of COVID-19 and one of white supremacy) and making sure that we are intersectional and supporting one another during this time is critical. As a Latina who is married to a South Asian immigrant, I feel passionately about building coalition to fight against anti-Asian attacks.

8. Do you believe that Asian and Pacific Americans are adequately represented in local government? What can elected officials do to improve participation?

No, I do not. I think it's important that we create pathways into politics from a young age with Asian American student leaders. We need to make sure that all our commissions, especially our youth commission, have Asian and Pacific American representation and that we are celebrating APA student leaders at all our schools.

I was supportive of Assemblymember David Chiu when I lived in San Francisco and worked with his former staff, Genesis Garcia, on community events.
